3.2 ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

3.3 LICENCES

The events will be open to all riders holding an AusCycling All Disciplines Membership or Off-Road Membership.

3.4 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except sprockets) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- 20", 24" & MTB bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the riders responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active [subscription](#).
- Transponders can be purchased [here](#).
- Hills WILL NOT have HIRE Transponders for this event.
- Hills however do have some Transponders available to purchase.

3.5 RACE PLATES

- Riders must ensure they have the correct Race Plate as detailed under section 3.02 of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX](#).

3.6 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All Riders/Parents are required to attend the Event Registration (sign on).
- All riders must check their transponder number at Sign On for the event to assure it's the right one.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- ~~Parents, guardians must scan Sprocket licences at the transponder checking station.~~
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

4 RACE INFORMATION

4.1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

The event will be conducted under ~~the rules and regulations~~ [Technical Regulations](#) of AusCycling Australia (AC) and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI).

4.2 RACE FORMAT

Current UCI Rules apply using Scrambled Moto transfer system for all categories except for participation. Block format may apply pending rider entries. Gate positions for Motos will be random computer drawn. Total points to end of motos followed by Qualifiers and Finals. Gate positions for Qualifiers and Finals are in order of lap time from the previous Stage or Round.

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX](#).

The race format for the 2022 Hills Tri Series is as follows:
