Event Information

- <u>LICENCES</u>: The event is open to all riders holding an AusCycle Competition Licence for all disciplines or Competition Licence for off road disciplines. Age determination is 31st December 2023.
- <u>CLOSE OF ENTRIES</u>: Official entry must be completed online via Entryboss. No Late Entries will be received. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the riders/riders guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, class and plate number.
- <u>ENTRIES MASTERS GAMES</u>: Entry into Masters Games is open to anyone 25 years of age and over. Riders must enter their natural age and gender. All entries receive a gift cooler bag with voucher to local retailers and other material.
- <u>REFUNDS MASTERS GAMES</u>: No refunds after close of entries unless due to medical or bereavement reasons, in which case there will be a refund, less a \$20.00 administration fee. A medical certificate is required.
- <u>REFUNDS MINI MASTERS</u>: No refunds after the close of entries unless due to medical or bereavement reasons, in which case there will be a full refund. A medical certificate is required
- <u>FORMAT</u>: The event will consist of 3 Motos (weather permitting) followed by Qualifiers (held directly after 3rd Moto) and 4th Moto/Finals. Consolation finals for all classes except Superclass.
- <u>CLASSES</u>: Three (3) registered riders constitute a class on the day. Classes will be merged based on undersubscribed classes at the close of Registration. For Masters Games, classes will be merged but scored separately. For Mini Masters, classes will be merged and scored as one
- <u>TRANSFERS & SCORING</u>: As per AusCycling Technical Regulations: BMX, Rules 2.03.02 a) Class of more than 1 full gate and 2.03.03 a) Class of 1 full gate or less will be used. Tie Breaker will use Rule 2.03.05.
- <u>TRANSPONDERS</u>: Transponders will be used for this event. Riders will be scored DNS if they do not have a working transponder fitted to their bike. Sprockets/Mini Wheelers do not require a transponder.
- <u>CLEAT PEDALS</u>: Interlocking pedal cleat systems are NOT to be used by Sprockets, Mini Wheelers or riders enter in 8-12 year challenge or cruiser classes. No exceptions.
- AUSCYCLE CODE OF CONDUCT applies to all riders, spectators and volunteers.
- ALCOHOL & SMOKING: All tracks and their environs are alcohol & smoke free
- ANIMALS: Animals are not permitted at the track or its environs.
