The categories below will be run for the 2026 Hills BMX Tri Series. For a category to be held, at least three (3) riders must be registered in that category.

ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

Categories will be offered as per the current [AusCycling Technical Regulations - General, Annexure 5](#) and as per [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX Racing, 1.03\(A\) SANCTIONING MATRIX \(A\)](#).

TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except mini wheelers & sprockets) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active [subscription](#).
- Hills WILL NOT have HIRE transponders for the event. Hills will however have transponders available for sale

EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration.
- Auto Registration will be conducted for all classes (except Mini wheelers and Sprockets) EACH ROUND, where a rider will have to complete a full lap of the track to register in their NOMINATED PRACTICE TIMES. It is the parent/rider's responsibility to check www.our.sqorz.com and make sure their entry has registered.
- If a lap has been completed and the rider is not registered, then please check that the transponder number on the bike matches the one on the Rider's profile and present yourself to the registration hut.
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct.
- Mini Wheelers & Sprockets will need to present their digital membership at the nominations hut to register

RACE INFORMATION

RACE FORMAT

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.05 of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX Racing](#).

The race format for the Hills Tri Series is as follows:

SERIES QUALIFYING

- You **MUST** race 2 Rounds to qualify for the overall series.
- **BUT overall points will be counted over the THREE (3) rounds**
- Points will be awarded for all motos & finals/extra motos
- Overall points will be scored on NOMINATED CLASSES, even if classes are merged at Round 1. Example, if the 11 girls' class is merged into the 12 girls class riders will still be scored overall as the 11 girls class

SERIES POINTS

The Hills Tri Series points will be awarded based on the finishing place within moto/finals, in accordance with the table below:

CHALLENGE, CRUISER, JUNIOR SUPERCLASS AND SUPERCLASS CATEGORIES

For Challenge, Junior Superclass and Superclass categories, the following will be provided:

Rule 2.05 will be applied for any competitor who does not start the final / last moto which means they will not qualify for event awards and series qualification rounds & points if applicable.

PLEASE NOTE: Merged category payouts will be in accordance with UCI Part 6 technical regulations 6.1.014

DISTRIBUTION OF SERIES AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY

ALL categories will be issued their awards/prize money on the final day at conclusion of racing.
