ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss [change if using another entry system] only. Entries will be uploaded into Sgorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

Categories will be offered as per the current [AusCycling Technical Regulations - General, Annexure 5](#) and as per [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX Racing, 1.03\(A\) SANCTIONING MATRIX \(A\)](#).

TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except sprockets) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active [subscription](#).
- Transponders can be purchased [here](#).

EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration.
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

RACE INFORMATION

RACE FORMAT

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.05.02 of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX Racing](#).

Rule 2.05.04, will be applied for any competitor who does not start the final / last moto which means they will not qualify for event awards and series qualification rounds & points if applicable.

Prize money will be allocated as per Race Class during the event.



DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY

MiniWheelers & Sprockets will receive their award in a break, prior to Finals, on Sunday 2nd November 2025.

Challenge, Burdekin Cup 13yrs, Junior Superclass and Superclass categories will be issued their awards/prize money on the day at the conclusion of all finals on Sunday 2nd November 2025.
