## 3 EVENT ENTRIES

---

### 3.1 EVENT CATEGORIES

The below categories will be run for the Jingili All Stars. In order for a category to be held, at least three (3) riders must be registered in that category.

Novice Class (20")	No Gender Division	8-10, 11-13
Challenge (Standard 20")	Male & Female	8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14-16, 17-29
Challenge (Cruiser 24")	No Gender Division	8-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-29
Challenge (Cruiser 24")	Male	30+ (Male only)
Masters (20")	Male	30+
Masters (Open Wheel – 20" or 24")	Female	30+
Mountain Bike	No Gender Division	14+

### 3.2 ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category and plate number.

Late entries will be taken on the day of racing before registration closes at 5pm. Please message Jingili BMX Club on Facebook or via SMS on 0492 974 828 to advise of your intention to nominate late. A \$5 late fee may apply.

### 3.3 MEMBERSHIP

The events will be open to all riders holding an current AusCycling 4 week free trial, All Discipline Membership or Off-Road Membership.

### 3.4 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except mini wheelers, sprockets and novice class) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active [subscription](#).
- Transponders can be purchased from Jingili BMX Club for \$55, this includes one (1) years subscription.

### 3.5 RACE PLATES

- Riders must ensure they have the correct Race Plate as detailed under section 3.02 of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX](#).
- Riders with duplicate plates in the same category may be required to add an 'X' on their race number.

### 3.6 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event before the close of registration at 5:00pm.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.

- Parents or guardians of Mini Wheelers, Sprocket Rockets and Novice class riders must register at the registration hut before close of registration.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

## 4 RACE INFORMATION

---

### 4.1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

The event will be conducted under Technical Regulations of AusCycling Australia (AC) and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI).

These Technical Regulations are supplementary to the following:

### 4.2 RACE FORMAT

Current UCI Rules apply using Scrambled Moto transfer system for all categories except for participation. Gate positions for Motos will be random computer drawn. Total points to end of motos followed by Qualifiers and Finals. Gate positions for Qualifiers and Finals are in order of lap time from the previous Stage or Round.

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the [AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX](#).

*Each competitor rides an extra moto with awards/prizes being awarded on total accumulated points, however, should there be any ties in accumulated points placing then the results in the extra moto are used to separate any such ties (assigned gates).*

The race format for the Jingili All Stars is as follows:

Category	Race Format
Sprocket Rockets and Novice Class	4 Motos
Challenge/Cruiser	4 Motos, Finals/5th Moto
Masters	4 Motos, Finals/5th Moto

## 5 AWARDS & PRIZING

---

### 5.1 MINI WHEELERS, SPROCKET ROCKETS AND NOVICE CLASSES

All Mini Wheelers, Sprocket Rockets and Novice classes will receive a trophy for their participation.

Mini Wheeler presentations will be held at the completion of their race, at approximately 5:30pm. Sprocket Rocket and Novice class presentations will be held during the break (after the 4th moto).

### 5.2 CHALLENGE AND MASTERS CATEGORIES

For Challenge classes and Masters the following will be provided:

Category	Prize	Placing
Challenge (Standard 20" and Cruiser 24")	Prize Money	1st Place (\$50), 2nd Place (\$30), 3rd Place (\$20), 4th – 8th Place (\$10)
Mountain Bike	Prize Money	1st Place (\$50), 2nd Place (\$30), 3rd Place (\$20), 4th – 8th Place (\$10)
Masters	Prize Money	1st Place (\$50), 2nd Place (\$30), 3rd Place (\$20), 4th – 8th Place (\$10)

**Please Note:** Merged Category payouts will be in accordance with [UCI Part 6 Technical Regulations 6.1.014](#).

*Combination of Categories and Results 6.1.014 "In any case where two or more categories are combined, the results of the combined categories must be split back into the original, separate categories based on the results summary for the combined categories. The UCI will only award points in the UCI BMX ranking based upon the separated results. Also, the riders are awarded the prize money that corresponds with their place in the separated results."*

### 5.3 DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY

All categories will be issued their awards/prize money on the day at the conclusion of the final (or last race for each category).

## 6 VENUE INFORMATION

---

The following are prohibited at Jingili BMX Club:

- Smoking (including E-Cigarettes or other vaping devices), please follow the signs to the designated smoking area outside of the main venue
