### 3.2 ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

### **MEMBERSHIP**

### 3.3 The events will be open to all riders holding an AusCycling Race All Discipline Membership or Race Off-Road Membership.

### 3.4 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except sprockets and mini wheelers) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this
  event. (There are limited number of transponders available to hire at \$10.00 per transponder)
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the rider's responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active <u>subscription</u>.
- Transponders can be purchased <u>here</u>.

### 3.5 RACE PLATES

- Riders must ensure they have the correct Race Plate as detailed under section 3.02 of the <u>AusCycling</u> Technical Regulations – BMX.
- Riders with duplicate plates in the same category may be required to add an 'X' on their race number.

### 3.6 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration (sign on).
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

### 4 RACE INFORMATION

### 4.1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

The event will be conducted under Technical Regulations of AusCycling Australia (AC) and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI).

These Technical Regulations are supplementary to the following:

- AusCycling Technical Regulations General
- AusCycling Technical Regulations BMX

### 4.2 RACE FORMAT

Current UCI Rules apply using Scrambled Moto transfer system for all categories except for participation. Gate positions for Motos will be random computer drawn. For categories of 8 or less riders total points to end of motos. For categories with 8+ riders total points to end of motos then followed by Qualifiers and Finals. Gate positions for Qualifiers and Finals are in order of lap time from the previous Stage or Round.

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX</u>.

The race format for the 2023 Twilight Series is as follows for each round:

Min Wheelers and Sprockets	5 Motos
Challenge/Cruiser	4 Motos, Finals
Open Wheel 17+	4 Motos, Finals
Junior Superclass	4 Motos, Finals
Superclass	4 Motos , Finals

### 5 AWARDS & PRIZING

### **5.1 PARTICIPATION AWARD**

All riders entering and competing in all 3 rounds of the series (you must enter the series via Entry Boss) will receive a participation award. Where classes are merged riders will be awarded on the class entered.

### 5.2 SPROCKETS AND MINI WHEELERS

All Sprockets and Mini Wheelers will receive an award for participation.

### 5.3 CHALLENGE, MASTERS, JUNIOR SUPERCLASS AND SUPERCLASS CATEGORIES

For Challenge, Masters, Junior Superclass and Superclass categories, the following will be provided:

Challenge (Standard 20" and Cruiser 24")	Trophy	1 <sup>st</sup> 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> place
Open Wheel 17-29 and 30+	Trophy	1 <sup>st</sup> 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> place
Junior Superclass	Trophy and Prize Money	1st Place (33%), 2nd Place (23%), 3rd Place (14%), 4th – 8th Place (8%)
Superclass	Trophy and Prize Money	1st Place (33%), 2nd Place (23%), 3rd Place (14%), 4th – 8th Place (8%)
*\$1000 Series prize pool, plus 50% payback		

USCYCLING

For Superclass & Junior Superclass categories 50% payback will be based on the entries per gender (i.e. 50% of male Superclass entry fees will go into the male Superclass prize pool, and 50% of female Superclass entry fees will go into the female Superclass prize pool).

**Please Note:** Merged Category payouts will be in accordance with <u>UCI Part 6 Technical Regulations</u> 6.1.014.

### 5.4 DISTRIBUTION OF AWARDS / PRIZE MONEY

All riders will be issued their awards on the day at the conclusion of the final (or last race for each category).

Junior Superclass and Superclass categories will receive their prize money via EFT (as soon as is reasonably practical following the event). Riders are to provide their bank details via email to [Insert Club Email].

### 6 VENUE INFORMATION

The following are prohibited at Launceston BMX Club

- Pets
- Alcohol
- Smoking (including E-Cigarettes or other vaping devices) (There is a smoking area in the carpark, 4m away from the fence line).

All attendees at the LBMXC 2023 Twilight Series are required to adhere to the <u>AusCycling Code of Conduct</u>. Failure to do so, or to follow any reasonable direction provided by Launceston BMX Club, or appointed officials at the event, may result in removal from the venue or exclusion from competition.
