# 2 EVENT ENTRIES

#### 2.1 EVENT CATEGORIES

The below categories will be run for the Presidents Cup. In order for a category to be held, at least 3 riders must be registered in that category.

Challenge (Standard 20")	Male & Female	8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 – 16
Challenge (Jnr Cruiser 24")	Male & Female	8-12, 13-16
Open Wheel	Male & Female	17+

# 2.2 ENTRY PROCESS & COST

Entry will be online via EntryBoss only. Entries will be uploaded into Sqorz after entries have closed. It is the rider's/rider's guardian's responsibility to ensure that their entry is correct. This includes transponder number, category, and plate number.

#### 2.3 MEMBERSHIP

2.4 The events will be open to all riders holding an AusCycling All Discipline Membership or Off-Road Membership.

#### 2.5 TRANSPONDERS

- All riders (except sprockets) will need to provide their own transponder to enter this event.
- 20" and 24" bikes will need separate transponders unless prior approval has been received.
- It is the riders responsibility to ensure that the transponder is correctly fitted to their bike and is operational which includes an active <u>subscription</u>.
- Transponders can be purchased <u>here</u>.
- There will be a limited number of transponders available for hire

# 2.6 RACE PLATES

- Riders must ensure they have the correct Race Plate as detailed under section 3.02 of the <u>AusCycling</u> <u>Technical Regulations – BMX</u>.
- Riders with duplicate plates in the same category may be required to add an 'X' on their race number.

#### 2.7 EVENT REGISTRATION (SIGN ON)

- All riders are required to attend the Event Registration.
- All riders must take their bikes to the transponder checking station to register for the event.
- Riders entered in two (2) categories (i.e. 20" and 24") must take both bikes to register in both categories.
- It is the responsibility of the rider/parent/guardian to check all details are correct at the transponder checking station.

# **RACE INFORMATION**

#### 2.8 RULES AND REGULATIONS

The event will be conducted under Technical Regulations of AusCycling Australia (AC) and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI).

These Technical Regulations are supplementary to the following:

#### 2.9 RACE FORMAT

Current UCI Rules apply using Scrambled Moto transfer system for all categories except for participation. Block format may apply pending rider entries. Gate positions for Motos will be random computer drawn. Total points to end of motos followed by Qualifiers and Finals. Gate positions for Qualifiers and Finals are in order of lap time from the previous Stage or Round.

A category of one (1) full gate or less (i.e. eight (8) riders or less riders) will be run in accordance with section 2.03.03 a) of the <u>AusCycling Technical Regulations – BMX</u>.

The race format for the President's Cup is as follows:

Sprockets	5 Motos
Challenge/ Jnr Cruiser / Open Wheel	3 Motos, Qualifiers, Finals

### **3 AWARDS & PRIZING**

#### 3.1 MINI WHEELERS and SPROCKETS

All Mini Wheelers and Sprockets will receive an award for participation.

#### **3.2 CHALLENGE CATERGORIES**

Classes that have been merged will be awarded on their entered class.

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class will be awarded a trophy. All other riders will be awarded a participation award.

# **4 VENUE INFORMATION**

The following are prohibited at Launceston BMX Club

- Pets
- Alcohol
- Smoking (including E-Cigarettes or other vaping devices). Smoking area is in carpark, away from the staging area.

All attendees at the Presidents Cup are required to adhere to the <u>AusCycling Code of Conduct</u>. Failure to do so, or to follow any reasonable direction provided by Launceston BMX Club, or appointed officials at the event, may result in removal from the venue or exclusion from competition.
