All open classes ex. Superclass Men & Women with min. of 8 riders registered for 2021 SCC eligible	Superclass Men & Women with a min. of 8 riders each for 2021 SCC are both eligible **
3 x eligible classes randomly selected	1 x Male & 1 x Female representative will be nominated by the rider group to conduct a coin toss
8 x riders randomly selected for each of the 3 classes drawn	The winner of the Coin Toss will determine who will compete in the Superclass Dash 4 Cash – Male or Female 8 x riders randomly selected
